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Southampton Solent University Health and Safety Policy

General Statement

Southampton Solent University is fully committed to developing, promoting and maintaining a pro-active approach to the management of health and safety by adopting a risk management approach, ensuring that hazards arising from our work activities are identified and addressed as a part of 'business as usual'.

Southampton Solent University commits to:

- embedding health and safety in all normal day-to-day work activities.
- preventing injury and ill health by effectively controlling risk.
- promoting staff and student wellbeing.
- encouraging open and transparent health and safety processes, including the reporting of both accidents and near misses, within a 'no blame' culture.
- the full involvement of all staff, through their representative organisations.
- meeting current best practice.
- legal compliance; and
- ensuring our buildings, equipment, facilities, materials and working practices are safe and without undue risk to health.

The success of this policy relies on the commitment of both staff and students. The University requires all its staff to recognise their own personal responsibilities and to work safely and with due consideration for others, wherever University activities are taking place. The University has an agreed set of health and safety roles and responsibilities describing individual responsibilities, and those associated with all job titles, this can be found on the Health and Safety pages of the staff portal.

The University operates a Health and Safety work plan which identifies our goals for the next year and the strategies for achieving them.

All staff are provided with an induction and regular health and safety training. Consultation with staff via the Health, Safety & Environmental Coordinators Improvement Forum and the University Health and Safety Committee ensures staff share information and best practice for continual improvement.
