Lisa-Jane is a Chartered Surveyor with thirty years' experience working client-side for owners, occupiers and investors of extensive and complex property portfolios. Her skills lie in developing property and estates strategies which generate income and value and support and enable business goals, and in leading and developing diverse, motivated teams. Lisa-Jane's career spans a number of different sectors including real estate, financial services and transport and infrastructure. She is currently Estates Management Director at Transport for London (TfL) and was a member of the leadership team that recently established an arms-length property company, wholly owned by TfL, but funded commercially, which will build homes for Londoners and return a growing investment income to invest in the transport network.

She is a Board Member and previous Board Chair, of the Association of Women in Property, a 1,000+ strong membership organisation that creates opportunities and inspires change for women working in the property and construction industry.

Lisa-Jane has a strong focus on sustainability and has participated in the Prince of Wales' Business and Sustainability Programme at Cambridge Institute of Sustainability Leadership.



Our Vice-Chancellor

Professor James Knowles

Professor James Knowles joined Solent from his role as Senior Vice-Principal for Education at Royal Holloway, University of London, where he was responsible for delivering clear, strategic leadership for all aspects of teaching and learning, student experience and student outcomes.

Educated at a comprehensive school, and the universities of London and Oxford, Professor Knowles has previously been Executive Dean and Vice-Principal of the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences at Royal Holloway, University of London, Professor of Renaissance Literature and Culture and Vice-Dean (Research) at Brunel University, London, and Professor of Medieval and Renaissance Literature and Head of the School of English at University College, Cork. As an academic, Professor Knowles specialised in early modern British literature and culture, especially the court masque and the work of Ben Jonson, John Marston, and Shakespeare. His interests include spatial semiotics and social choreography, the new histories of the book and manuscript culture, queer sexualities, bodies, and masculinities, cultural patronage and consumption, and early modern orientalisms, especially focused on South East Asia, India, and China.

He edited 32 works for the Cambridge Works of Ben Jonson, authored a monograph on The Court Masque and Political Culture, and in 1997 he recovered Jonson's lost Entertainment at Britain's Burse, the first major addition to Jonson's dramatic canon since 1814.

Professor Knowles has held numerous prestigious grants and awards include a Leverhulme Trust Research Fellowship, and fellowships from the Huntington Library, California, and the Harry Ransom Research Library, Texas.

As an academic leader, at Royal Holloway, his projects covered curriculum change, teaching, and learning development, the Access and Participation Plan, and working closely with the Students' Union to ensure the effectiveness of student representation and the



recognition of the student voice in education. He also chaired the university's Student Success project, which aimed to narrow attainment gaps for BGM and other students as well as working on a range of inclusion projects.

Professor Knowles is currently Strategic Reviewer for the Arts and Humanities Research Council and a Member of the AHRC Peer Review College, and has acted as a consultant to English Heritage, Historic Royal Palaces, and the Heritage of London Trust. In recent years he was a member of the UK Teaching Excellence Framework Subject Level Pilot panel, and he has been appointed to the main panel for TEF 2023 awards. Previous non-executive roles have included school governorships, an FE college governorships, and he currently sits on the board and is a trustee of AQA (Academic Qualifications Alliance), the UK's largest exam board, and he chairs the Gunnersbury and Museum and Park Development Trust, an Arts Council England National Portfolio Organisation, that manages 183 acres of historic parkland, two mansions, and 18 listed buildings in west London.

Honorary awards

The University will confer honorary degrees on the following individuals in recognition of their outstanding achievements.

Andrew Haldane CBE

Doctor of Economics

Andrew Haldane CBE is a distinguished economist and public leader, widely recognised for his contributions to economic policy, social impact, and cultural and educational advancement. He is the Chancellor of the University of Sheffield, President of the British Chambers of Commerce, Chair of the Glasshouse International Centre for Music, Chair of the Advanced Manufacturing Research Centre, Founder and President of the charity Pro Bono Economics and Chair of the National Numeracy Leadership Council.

He is a Contributing Editor at the Financial Times, Ambassador of the charities National Numeracy and Futures for All and a member of the advisory boards for the Bradford Literature Festival, the South Yorkshire Mayor's Economic Advisory Council, the Fora Work Institute and PwC.

Andrew is Honorary Professor at the University of Manchester and a Fellow of the Royal Society, the Academy of Social Sciences and the Royal Society of Arts.

Andrew was appointed Commander of the Order of the British Empire (CBE) in the 2019 New Year Honours for services to the economy. He has previously served as the Chief Economist at the Bank of England, a member of the Bank's Monetary Policy Committee and Financial Policy Committee, Permanent Secretary at the Cabinet Office, Chair of the Government's Industrial Strategy Council and Levelling Up Advisory Council and Chief Executive of the Royal Society of Arts. He has published over 200 academic articles and four books.



Honorary awards

Ewen Foster Doctor of Engineering

Ewen Foster, Chief Design Officer at Sunseeker International, is one of the driving forces behind the brand's global reputation for innovation, performance, and luxury. With over 51 years in the marine industry, including 41 years shaping Sunseeker's design DNA, he has been instrumental in creating some of the world's most recognisable and admired yachts.

A visionary in modern yacht design, Ewen has overseen the development of more than 90 Sunseeker hulls and the exterior styling of over 60 models, helping define the bold, dynamic aesthetic that has become synonymous with the Sunseeker name. Under his leadership, the company's Design and Engineering division has delivered over 160 projects, each reflecting his commitment to craftsmanship, technical excellence, and customer-focused innovation.

Ewen's partnership with Sunseeker began in 1985, when he joined Don Shead Ltd, the studio then responsible for the brand's design work. Recognising his talent and leadership potential, Sunseeker appointed him in the late 1980s to establish its in-house Design Office in Poole, a department that has since grown into a world-class team of around 60 specialists under his direction.

His career foundations were built early. Beginning as a Boatbuilding Apprentice at the Eyemouth Boatbuilding Company in 1975, he developed a deep understanding of traditional craftsmanship. He later earned national recognition at James Watt College, receiving the CGLI First Prize in the UK for Yacht and Boatbuilding. Further studies at the Southampton College of Higher Education



(now Southampton Solent University) and professional experience at Rival Yachts strengthened his technical and creative expertise.

Today, Ewen continues to guide Sunseeker's design strategy, ensuring every new model embodies the brand's hallmark blend of performance, luxury, and innovation. His influence can be seen across the entire Sunseeker fleet, making him a central figure in the company's ongoing success and global appeal.

Honorary awards

Doctor of Business

Phil Parsons joined Southampton Football Club as Chief Executive Officer in the summer of 2023.

Prior to joining Southampton, Phil spent 15 years with pioneering technology company Dyson, holding a number of senior leadership roles across Europe, Asia and the Middle East. His career also saw him live and work abroad for many years, including in Ireland, France, Italy and the Middle East, giving him a broad global perspective and deep understanding of diverse markets and cultures.

His final role at Dyson was as President of Europe, Middle East and Africa, where he was responsible for almost 40% of the company's global business, overseeing multi-billion-pound revenues and leading thousands of employees across the region.

As CEO of Southampton Football Club, Phil works alongside ownership on overall strategy and operations, working closely with the Executive team to deliver sustainable success on and off the pitch. Alongside the football operation, he has also helped shape wider commercial and real estate opportunities around the club, driven by a passion to help transform Southampton and the St Mary's area. He believes diversified revenues and long-term asset development are key to strengthening the club's future sustainability and competitiveness.
